October Brown Bag Seminar

"Nothing But Sorrow, Trouble, and Worry: Glimpses From The Ozark Civil War Home-front"

On October 12, 2012, there were 48 participants who attended the Brown Bag Seminar to learn about the Civil War History of North West Arkansas. Susan Young with the Shiloh Museum of Ozark History was the guest presenter. There were 620,000 people killed in the war.

She told about the Battles of Pea Ridge and Prairie Grove and the affect that it had on the local families, brothers fighting brothers, sons against fathers, etc. She read several letters written by local residents who lived in Northwest Arkansas at the time of the war and were sent to other family members outside the region. The letters gave a vivid view of what was actually happening. The local women who were left behind because their husbands and sons were off fighting the war, had the hard task of protecting their homes and children from raids, vandalism, stealing, and robbery by homeless locals, Union soldiers, and others. The times were dangerous and hard!

Susan stated that everyone thought President Lincoln supported the war to free the slaves, but his main reason was to save the Union. He knew that if the war did not end, there would not be a nation. This issue is still debated to this day.

Susan invited the participants to visit the museum, as well as



NWACC Graphics Art Class Visits Bella Vista TV Station


