The key items below are provided to highlight some of the information that is extremely important to students.

- I understand my NWACC email account is the official form of communication. I must monitor this account regularly for important Financial Aid information.
- I have read and understand the 2013-2014 Satisfactory Academic Progress Policy and the Satisfactory Academic Progress section in the orientation.
- I have read and understand the new regulations regarding unusual and probable enrollment patterns and limited subsidized student loan borrowing.
- I understand that I must begin attending and/or participating in my classes on the first day of class. If I fail to do so, it will impact my ability to receive federal funds for the semester.
- I understand that I must be enrolled in 6 credit hours to receive a federal loan.
- I understand loans are always disbursed in two disbursements. Normally, one in the fall and one in the Spring. If I have a one semester loan such as Spring only or Summer only loan, the loan will be credited to my account in two disbursements. The first half after I am attending 6 hrs and the drop period is over and the second half after the midpoint of the semester.
- I understand that there is a 30 calendar day delay in the disbursement for first time freshman student loan borrowers.
- I understand and acknowledge that NWACC does not issue credit balance checks prior to the start of the semester.
- I have read and understand the disbursement of funds section in the orientation.
- I understand that a book credit may be offered to me to use at the Barnes and Noble bookstore on campus. If I elect not to use the book credit it will be removed from my student account after the book credit deadline. If I elect to use the book credit, the estimated amount will be removed from my student account after the deadline and replaced with the amount I actually charged.
- I understand and acknowledge that the Financial Aid Office credits funds to my student account and the Cashier's Office issues book credits and credit balance checks.
