1. Only 20% of children have an opportunity to attend primary school.
1. The majority of Haitian children do not attend school after the primary grades.
3. The majority of schools in Haiti do not have cafeterias. 60% of Haitian children do not receive 3 meals per day. Most children get little or nothing for breakfast or lunch.

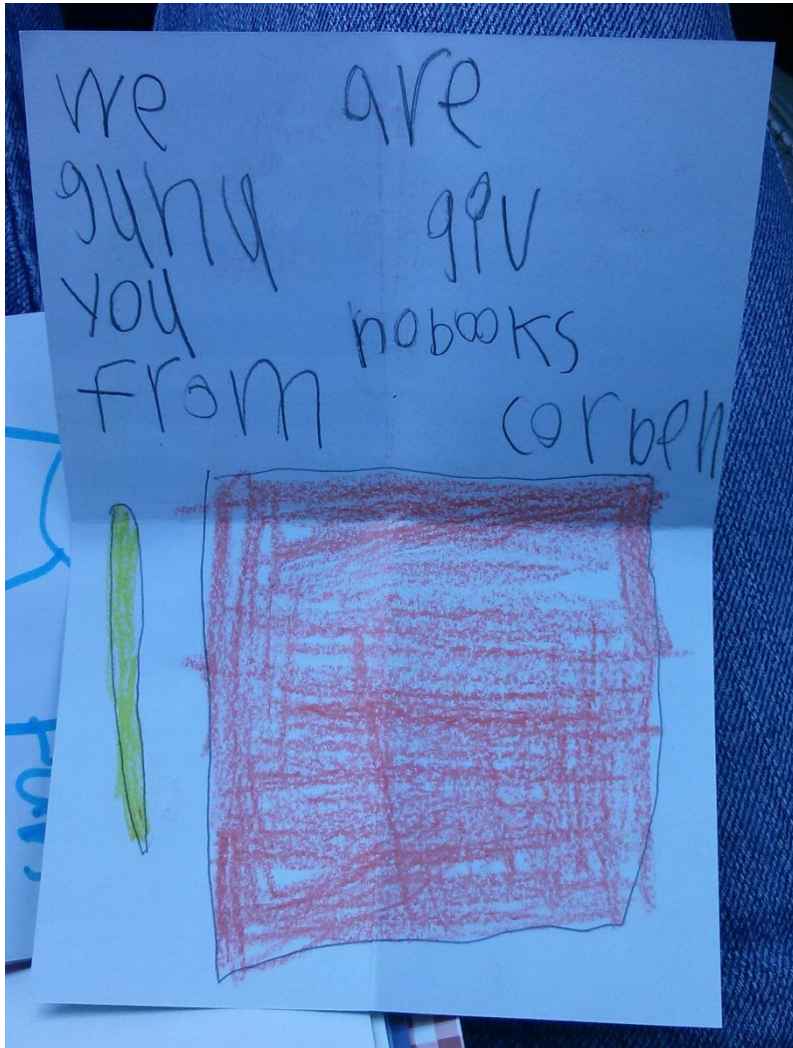
