How to schedule NWACC testing appointments on the Bentonville Campus

To schedule an NWACC testing appointment on Accudemia, follow these steps:

- 1. Open <u>nwacc.accudemia.net</u>
- 2. Log-In using your NWACC email address and password.
- 3. Click the **blue** "Schedule Appointment" box.
- 4. Choose a testing option:

- Computer Based Testing: Select this if you are taking an exam or quiz on Canvas or MyMathLab.

- Disability Accommodation Testing: Select this if you are using Disability Resource Center-approved accommodations.

- Paper/Pencil Testing: Select this if you are taking a paper/pencil test.

- 5. Click the **blue** "Continue" button.
- 6. Select your class subject area, then find your professor's name. If your professor is not listed, choose Other Instructor.
- 7. Under "Pick date and time" choose the <u>duration/length of your exam</u>. If you have accommodations, select the length including any additional time. Only the available times and testing stations will be displayed after you choose the length of your exam. If you are testing on Friday or Saturday and would like to test at 11:00am, you MUST choose your exam length as 1 hour, and you will be allowed to test until we close at 1:00pm.
